



Aggressive Hiring Competition Over an Average Supply of Regional Talent




Supply (Jobs)

Hampden County, MA is about average for this kind of talent. The national average for an area this size is 9,120* employees, while there are 8,685 here.



Earnings Per Job

Earnings per job are about the same as the national average. The national average salary for Finance and Insurance in an area this size is \$137,955, while in Hampden County, MA it is \$132,906. Earnings per jobs is the total industry earnings divided by the number of jobs in the industry.



Demand (Job Postings)

Competition from online job postings is high in Hampden County, MA. The national average for an area this size is 721* job postings/mo, while there are 819 here.




Supply Is About Equal to the National Average





Racial Diversity


Racial diversity is low in Hampden County, MA. The national average for an area this size is 2,665* racially diverse employees, while there are 1,569 here.

Unemployment shown at the 2-digit sector level.




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




Industry Race/Ethnicity Breakdown






Industry Gender Breakdown




